Wakefield and District Housing Community Grant Scheme

Wakefield and District Housing (WDH) is one of the country's largest registered providers and the largest rented housing provider in the Wakefield district.



WDH's **Vision** is to create **confident communities**.

The aim of the Community Grant Scheme is to contribute to the work of WDH and the Vision by providing small grants to local community groups in WDH communities to help them start up, hold events and / or provide equipment.



Can my group apply for a community grant?

So that grants are awarded to groups within the communities in which WDH operates, and benefits community members, you or your group cannot apply if you are:

- An Individual or sole trader.
- A commercial business and / or registered company, partnership or mutual.
- A profit making organisation.
- A political organisation.
- An organisation which promotes religious activities (where the grant is to be used for religious activity).
- An educational establishment.
- A statutory or government funded organisation.
- A Town or Parish Council.
- Organisations not established in the UK.
- Groups directly involving a WDH employee.
- National or regional organisations and / or charities (subject to the criteria specified in the scheme)



If none of these apply to your group then you may be eligible to apply, however, you should consider the detailed criteria in the Guide for Applicants before completing the application form.

How are decisions made to award a community grant?

Once an application has been validated against the scheme criteria, they are considered by the Local Management Committee for the area in which the group operates.



The LMC will consider the information provided in your application against the criteria and aims and objectives of the Community Grant Scheme, which you can find in the Guide for Applicants available on our website.
