What's it all about?

Neighbourhood Management is a ground breaking scheme which aims to make sure local people can play a key part in improving services in their community.

Wakefield and District Housing (WDH) is working with the Wakefield District Partnership to deliver the Airedale and Ferry Fryston Neighbourhood Management Pilot.

By working closely with tenants and residents, businesses, community organisations, the local authority and service providers, WDH aims to ensure services are improved for the benefit of the whole area.

How does it work?

The Neighbourhood Management process puts local people at the heart of the decision making process.

Through Neighbourhood Management people will be able to identify issues in their area and decide which ones need addressing first. This will help to develop a local strategy to improve the area.

The Board — local people's voices

A Board has been set up to make sure local people's voices are heard, ensure organisations work together to improve services in the area and promote the work of the Neighbourhood Management Pilot.
